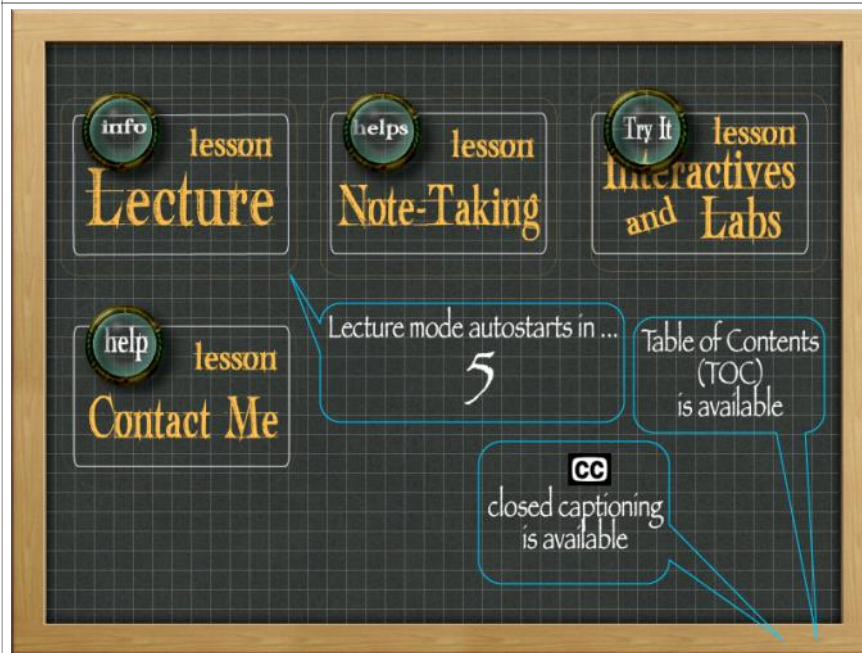


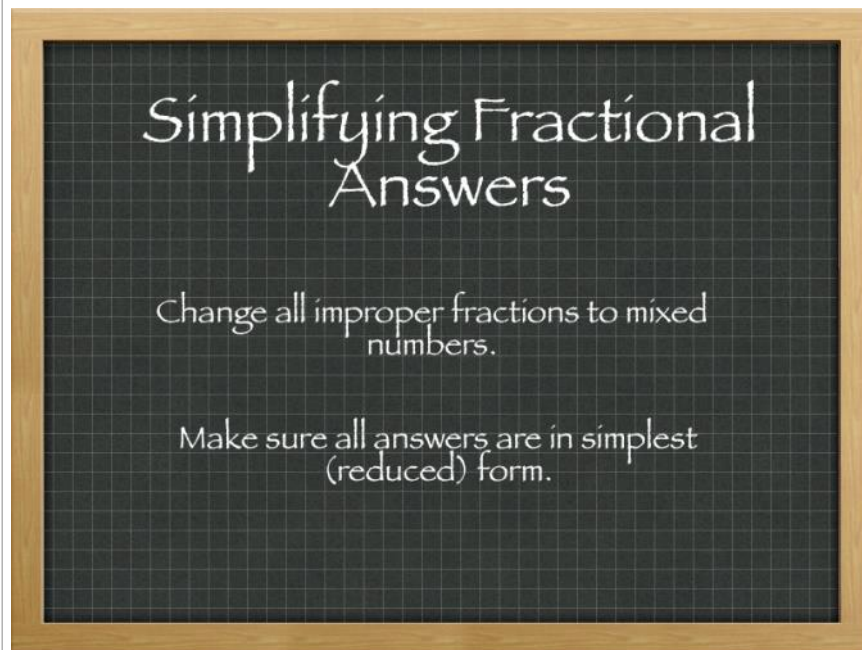
# Simplifying Fraction Answers
